

# CARTER, SWEENEY ARE NOMINATED ON BOTH TICKETS

County Clerk Gets 153 Democratic Votes — 276 Republicans for Sweeney

County Clerk George R. Carter and Treasurer Ralph Sweeney, unopposed in the primary, will enjoy the same condition in the November election, by virtue of write-in votes, outside their party, assuring them the

nomination of both the Republican and Democratic tickets. Clerk Carter received 153 Democratic write-in votes, and Treasurer Sweeney received 276 Republican write-in votes. The official count for constable for the Medford district shows Nick Young, incumbent, renominated by a majority of 951 over Albert Stevens. Young received 2,037 votes, Stevens 1,086. For Democratic national committeeman, the final count shows Howard Latourette received 1,714 and Flavel Temple 1,085 votes. For Democratic national committeewoman, the count was: Emily Edson 982, Nora Hitchman 805, Celia Gavin 560. Tabulation of the vote for other Democratic offices, national, state and county, is now underway, and owing to the number of write-ins for every-
