## Old Faithful Suzy

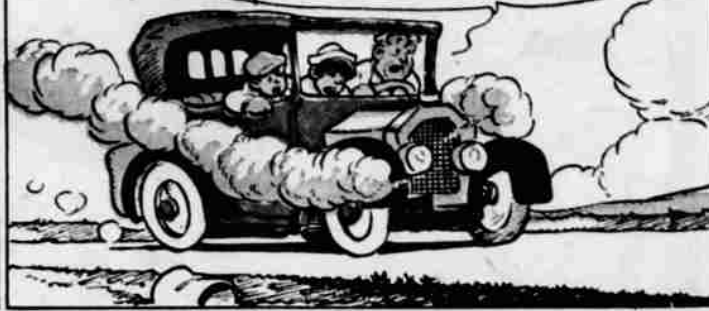

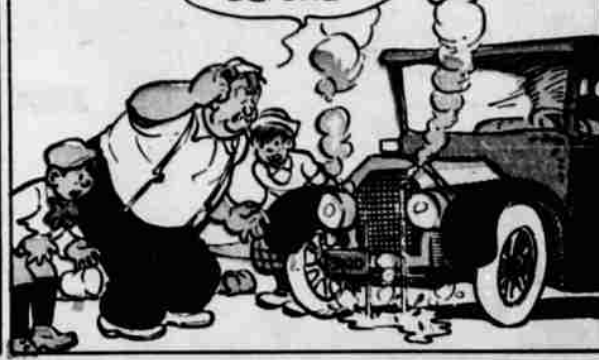
