The public is invited and there will be no admission charge.

FAMILIAR NAMES ON OLD ARMY LIST

In the course of routine business in this county clerk's office, the military list of Jackson county for 1887 was dusted off recently. In the light of what is going on militarily in the world and nation today, it holds some interest.

There are 1,187 names on the list. The one appearing most frequently is Pankey, a pioneer southern bred and pioneer southern Oregon family of the Central Point district.

Others include Charles Strang, Medford; Frank Amy, now living at Union Creek; John Matney and John Wingham of the Applegate section, Frank Bybee of Jacksonville, William H. Gore, then of Ashland, Emil Britt of Jackson ville, and G. F. Billings, Ash land.

FEHL MAKES APPEAL TO SUPREME COURT IN LIBERTY EFFORT

Earl H. Fehl, former Jackson county judge, now an inmate of the Oregon State hospital at Salem, has filed notice of appeal to the state supreme court from an order of the circuit court, signed May 25, denying Fehl's appeal from the Jackson county court to the Jackson county circuit court.

Fehl's insanity hearing in December, 1937, was certified from the county court to the circuit court by County Judge Earl B. Day, and testimony in the insanity hearing was heard by Circuit Judge H. D. Norton. Fehl was ordered committed to the state hospital. Through his attorney, R. R. Hewitt of Salem, Fehl now contends his case was never heard in the circuit court.

Circuit Judge Carl Hendricks of Fossil, heard the arguments on this contention, and in a decision May 25, last, denied the appeal.

Fehl recently sought a writ of habeas corpus for his release from the state hospital. Hearing on the writ was held in a Multnomah county court, and denied.

PILOT TRAINING PLACES CHOSEN

Seattle, July 11.—(AP)—Wiley R. Wright, area director for the civil aeronautics authority's civilian pilot training program, announced today plans for immediate establishment of 12 Pacific northwest pilot training stations for non-college persons between 18 and 26.

School sites include Salem, Klamath Falls and Ontario, Ore.

They will be sponsored by local chambers of commerce. Applicants must have student pilot certificates and be residents of the state in which they apply. The non-collegiate schools will supplement training courses now being given 1,060 persons at 40 Pacific northwest colleges.

BODY FOUND UPRIGHT IN MUD OF COLUMBIA

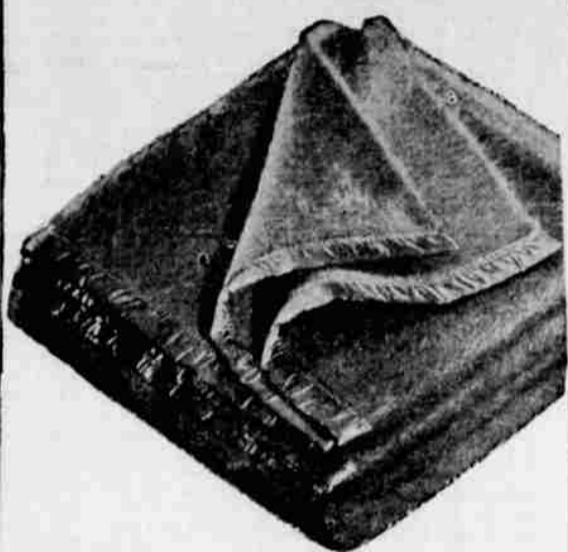

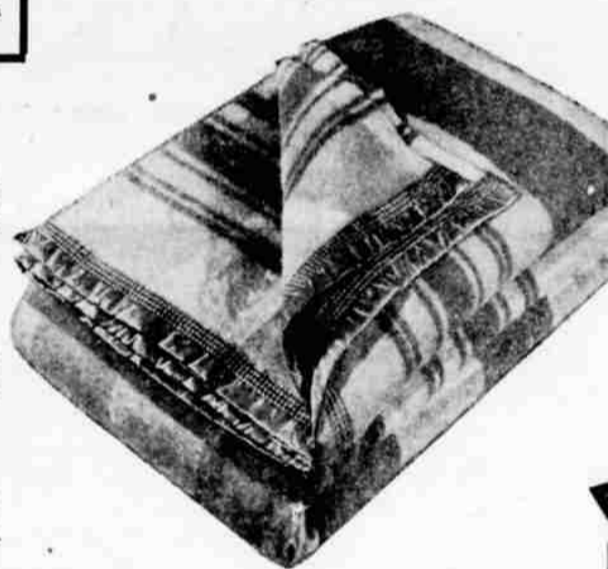

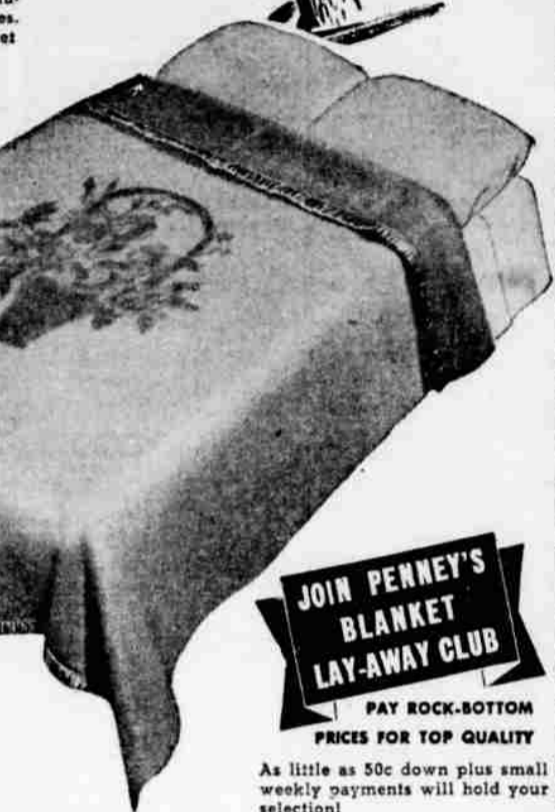
