

# Douglas Fairbanks, Jr. And Madeleine Carroll Head Cast Of "Safari"

## THRILLING DRAMA WITH BACKGROUND OF JUNGLE OPENS

March of Time Release Features Navy—Oregon Coast Films Billed.

An exceptional screen program that has Douglas Fairbanks, Jr., and Madeleine Carroll so-starring in "Safari," a thrilling jungle drama, as the feature attraction, opens a three-day showing today at the Craterian theater.

As added attractions on the same program the Craterian has the March of Time, presenting "The U. S. Navy—1940," and Graham McNamee's camera tour of the beautiful Oregon coastline.

"Safari," with Tullio Carminati, Lynne Overman and Billy Gilbert featured in the supporting cast, is based upon the eternal triangle, the determined battle of two men—Fairbanks and Marcinati—for the woman they both covet. Carminati has hired Fairbanks, a big game hunter, to head a safari into the jungle, and his insane jealousy almost results in the murder of his rival. Set against the thrilling background of the teeming jungle, with its ever present unseen and seen dangers, "Safari" has been classed as the "jungle thriller of 1940."

The March of Time subject, of special timeliness now that the eyes of the world are focused on Uncle Sam's huge national defense program, brings to the screen a story of a vitally important part of this program.

Featured in "The U. S. Navy—1940" are several scenes of the now historic naval disarmament conference of 1922, which resulted in the scrapping of more than half a million tons of U. S. warships, including unfinished cruisers and dreadnaughts.

The film shows the enlistment and training of the blue-jackets today, the operation of the naval R.O.T.C. unit in colleges and universities, the work of each type of vessel in the navy, the strategic importance

The McNamee subject, to be shown on the same program, brings to the screen scenes that are familiar to thousands of Oregonians, also many of the scenes widely publicized but hard to find. Filmed by a Universal camera crew, this subject is being given national release and will undoubtedly bring many visitors to this state.

## GAME VIOLATION BLAMED 4 DEATHS

Waterville, Minn., July 13.—(P)—Three game wardens and a fish buyer lay dead in this little southern Minnesota town today, victims of a triple slaying and a suicide which stemmed, officers believed, from illegal sale of bulletheads.

The wardens were shot to death yesterday as they questioned Bryant Baumgartner, about 60, as to whether he had a license to buy and ship bulletheads to Iowa. Immediately after the triple-slaying Baumgartner turned his 12-gauge shotgun on himself.

The victims, besides Baumgartner, were D. M. Brady, Windom, A. M. Holt, Worthington, and Marcus Whipp, Kansas.
