

ELY CULBERTSON QUILTS CARDS FOR POLITICAL WHIRL

Bridge Expert Would Show Gratitude for Riches Received by Entering Congress.

Ridgefield, Conn., Aug. 1.—(AP)—Ely Culbertson, who has stopped playing bridge, has gone into politics with all the enthusiasm he ever gave to cards because:

"The American people have handsomely supported, showered wealth upon me, and now I want to do something to express my gratitude, to serve them in congress and do what I can for them."

So the "king of bridge" is gunning for the Democratic nomination as Connecticut's congressman-at-large. Party leaders haven't said yet what they think of his candidacy.

"They ask so much in America, 'Why don't some of these rich men get into politics and seek to better it?' Well, that's what I'd like to do—to do something for the underdog," he says.

Is Linguist

Culbertson, born in Russia of an American father whose ancestry made him eligible to join the Sons of the American Revolution, promises, if nominated, to campaign in Ukrainian, French, Russian, German and Italian—all languages with which he is familiar.

Mr. and Mrs. Culbertson, divorced but on extremely friendly terms, occupy a 65-acre estate here, he living in the mansion house and she in one of the six "cottages" (actually large residences) on the property. Their children, 12-year-old Joyce and 11-year-old Bruce, spend five months a year with their mother and the other seven with their father.

of the railroad, expressed a similar view and said the coach's crew also disregarded a "rigid" rule in failing to obtain permission from the block operator at Hudson before continuing on the main track.

The freight train, northbound from Columbus, O., telescoped the fore end of the 122,000-pound coach, and shoved it back in its wake for 200 yards. Flames spurted from the windows as its 250-gallon gasoline tanks exploded. Firemen poured water into the coach. Then they and volunteers went about the sickening two-hour task of removing bodies, many so burned that identification was difficult.

Coroner R. E. Amos, seeking to clear up the identifications, said the passengers "didn't have a chance in the world" to escape.

Eye witnesses related that flames enveloped the coach so fast that none of the passengers

FRENCH LEADERS TO LOSE WEALTH AND CITIZENSHIP

Two Members of Rothschild Family Among Long List of Those Who Left Country.

Berlin, Aug. 1.—(AP) (via Radio).—A long list of prominent Frenchmen, reading like pages from France's pre-armistice Who's Who, have been ordered deprived of their citizenship and their properties confiscated, the German wireless announced today.

The list, the first since the Petain regime decreed action against those who left France "without valid reasons" between May 10 and June 30, included two members of the internationally known Rothschild banking family. It was broadcast by the government station at Vichy and picked up here.

The two Rothschilds were Baron Edouard, head of the French branch of the family's far-flung banking operations, and Baron Maurice, a member of the French senate.

(Baron Maurice De Rothschild arrived in Montreal this week with a cousin, Baron Robert De Rothschild, the latter's wife and daughter, after having taken temporary refuge in Britain. Baron Edouard, his baroness and their daughter arrived in New York July 10 by Clipper plane.)

(Baron Maurice, described by fellow passengers as "nervous and shaken" by his experiences, declined to comment today on the French government's action.)

Others on the list included some of France's leading industrialists, political leaders and journalists.

Most of the passenger victims were residents of the Akron district, although the coach, which shuttled the 12 miles from Hudson, O., to Akron, had picked up passengers at Hudson from the Pennsylvania's Cleveland-Pittsburgh line.

It was the second big American railroad tragedy in four months. Thirty-one persons died in the wreck of the New York Central's Lake Shore limited at Little Falls, N. Y., April 19.

F. B. I. AGENTS AND PEACE OFFICERS IN MEETING HERE

Handling of Information and Complaints of Fifth Column Activity Arranged.

Law enforcement officers of Jackson county met in the court house auditorium yesterday afternoon with J. D. Swenson, special agent in charge of the Portland office of the federal bureau of investigation, to complete arrangements for expeditious handling of information and complaints concerning matters affecting national defense and internal security.

The conference was one of a series being held in a number of cities between representatives of the F. B. I. and state, county and local police and sheriffs.

Aid Needed

In an F. B. I. news release explaining the purpose of the meetings, it was stated that the active assistance of police departments, sheriffs' offices and state police organizations was needed by the F. B. I. in its work on violations of the federal espionage, sabotage and neutrality acts.

The release said, further, that "it is important that all information relating to such matters be forwarded by private citizens as well as officials directly to the F. B. I. office in this area." Letters should be addressed to "special agent in charge, federal bureau of investigation, U. S. department of justice, 411 U. S. courthouse, P. O. box 709, Portland, Oregon." The telephone number of the F. B. I. office in Portland was given as ATwater 6171, extension 544. The office is now open 24 hours a day.

Close Relationship

The meeting yesterday, according to the F. B. I., "characterized a still further and closer relationship between the F. B. I. and local agencies of law enforcement with reference to the vital problems of national defense and internal security. The wholehearted pledges of cooperation and splendid responses have been a source of gratification to the F. B. I. and likewise should be to the citizens of this state. In due course arrangements of this type will be completed with all law enforcement agencies of the country."
