## CAVEMEN GOING TO SALEM FETE

Grants Pass, Aug. 2.—(P)—Two dozen Oregon Cavemen and women will leave here Saturday morning for the Salem centennial, a parade in the capital city, and a campfire in the state capitol, which has some of the earmarks of a publicity stunt.

A prehistoric painting of a dinosaur, used in special rites will stay in the caverns. Chief Bighorn Don Cameron said he had learned Salem society leaders were cool toward the Cavemen because they had unsuccessfully planned the celebration as an affair of art without whiskeys, cowboys and wild men. Cameron said he was taking no chances of losing the painting. On the schedule north is a halt at Roseburg to recover from dizzy whirlings around Pacific highway curves, "raw cougar meat" at Eugene as guests of a "board of strategy," brief inspections of Corvallis and Albany, and arrival in Salem at 4:30.

## SOVIET CREATES MOLDAVIAN UNION

Moscow, Aug. 2.—(P)—The supreme council of the Russian parliament unanimously adopted a resolution today creating the Moldavian Union republic, in which is incorporated the larger part of Bessarabia, recently obtained from Rumania. This thirteenth member of the U. S. S. R. is made up of most of the old autonomous Moldavian republic, previously a part of the Ukraine, plus the newly acquired territory.
