Ontario Mayor Observes Sugar Time... George K. Alken, mayor of Ontario and publisher of the Ontario Argus, also member of Oregon state game commission, takes pen in hand to sign a proclamation setting aside the two-week period from August 2 to 17 as "Oregon Sugar Time"... And why shouldn't he, for hasn't the coming of this new industry to Oregon meant much to the farmers of eastern Oregon and, indirectly, as a matter of fact, to all the people living within the state? Mayor-Commissioner-Publisher Alken is proud of the fact that Malheur county, with a population gain of 75 per cent in the 10-year period just ended, led all counties in the state in population gains. Of course, the coming of the beet sugar industry to Malheur and the development of the big irrigation projects in that section had much to do with this growth... Last year the Oregon beet sugar industry produced more than \$3,500,000 of new wealth for the state. This year, with increased acreage and crops that look as good or better than those of 1939, approximately five million dollars in new wealth should result from this industry. This will benefit thousands of farmers, field and factory workers, livestock growers, railroad and lime quarry employees, bag makers, beet seed producers and every taxpayer in the state.
