

### NAZI SPY CHARGE BRINGS THREATS OF DEATH DAILY

Washington, Aug. 29.—(P)—Carl Byoir, New York publicity man, told the Dies committee today that daily threats of "death or worse" had been made to him as a result of Representative Patman (D-Texas) accusing him of being a Nazi spy and propagandist—accusations Byoir denied in toto.

Byoir testified after Patman had spent more than two hours presenting what he said was evidence that Byoir had been retained by Adolf Hitler to disseminate Nazi propaganda and, as a result, was unfit to hold his rank of lieutenant-colonel in the U. S. army reserve.

Byoir told the committee that in the 30 days since Patman first made his charges on the house floor there was scarcely a day that someone did not call his office and threaten him or write letters saying "we're going to blow you up."

He said this was directly due to Patman's assertion that he had no doubt that Byoir had been retained by the German government to set up the "greatest spy organization in the history of the world."

Byoir said flatly he could not believe Patman's statement that the congressman had no personal feeling against him and asserted there was "a long history of personal conflict" between them.

At that point, Brien McMahon, Byoir's counsel and former assistant attorney general, told the committee the reason Patman accused Byoir was that the latter had been the most effective opponent to a piece of "pet legislation" from which Patman had been receiving "a very healthy remuneration."

Chairman Dies (D-Texas) rebuked McMahon for his remarks.

### FILM PAIR, NEWLY DIVORCED, WEDDED

Santa Barbara, Calif., Aug. 30.—(P)—Laurence Olivier and Vivien Leigh, recently divorced by their respective spouses, became husband and wife early today and set out at once on a motoring honeymoon.

As their attendants they had the film and stage star, Katherine Hepburn, and youthful motion picture director Garson Kanin.

The four drove up from Hollywood last night.

Taking great pains to keep their movements secret, they picked up Municipal Judge Fred Harsh and the clerk of his court, Jack Lewis, and drove to Rancho San Ysidro, the home of their socialite friends, Mr. and Mrs. Al C. Weingand, in suburban Montecito.

There, just a minute after midnight on expiration of the three-day waiting period required by state law, they were married by Judge Harsh. They were believed planning a honeymoon at Del Monte, near San Francisco, but said only that they would be back for film assignments next Tuesday.

### JAPANESE CLOSE RIVER AT CANTON

Hongkong, Aug. 30.—(P)—Japanese authorities today closed the Pearl river at Canton to all commercial shipping for unexplained "military reasons."

Informed quarters here said Japanese troop movements were under way from Formosa to Canton.

The Japanese have closed the river several times in the past to screen troop movements. Today's order necessitated postponement of the scheduled departure for Canton of the United States South China patrol flagship Mindanao and also of a Standard Oil Company tanker.

British officials, meanwhile announced a settlement effective Sept. 1 of a dispute with pilots and stevedores which had caused a month's suspension of British and Japanese services between Hongkong and Canton. They are scheduled now to resume as soon as the Japanese reopen the river.

Justice Catches Fish. Astoria, Aug. 30.—(P)—Columbia river salmon for once were impressed by the importance of the fisherman. Supreme Court Justice W. O. Douglas landed a 24-pounder yesterday, the biggest fish caught by his party.
