

AIR LINE TRAFFIC SETS NEW RECORD AT CITY'S PORT

282 Passengers Arrived On Liners During August — 293 Boarded UAL Planes

All local traffic records were broken again here last month by United Air Lines, figures released today showed.

In August 282 passengers got off United Mainliners at Medford municipal airport and 293 got on, a total of 575. This compares with 256 off and 277 on passengers in July, a total of 533, and 220 off and 203 on passengers, or a total of 423, in August, 1939. Last month's traffic represented a gain of 7.8 per cent over that of July and 26 per cent over that of August a year ago. July was the previous high month.

A one day's record was also established last month. For a 24-hour period August 11-12, 14 passengers got on and 20 got off Mainliners here, a total of 34 for the day.

Last month 215 Mainliners made stops at the Medford airport, this number setting a new record. The operating of extra sections accounted for the increase over the July total of 208 planes. July was the previous high month.

The company announced a schedule change to become effective September 10. Beginning September 10 the early morning northbound plane will arrive here at 4:42 a. m. and leave at 4:47 a. m. This is ten minutes later than at present.

JACKSON COUNTY 4-H GIRLS WIN AT STATE FAIR

The first places in judging contests at the Oregon state fair in Salem were awarded to 4-H club girls from Jackson county, according to a telegram received by the Mail Tribune today from L. E. Francis, county 4-H agent. The fair opened yesterday.

Doris Hunsley and Jean Brenneholtz of the Table Rock 4-H club placed first as a team in the cooking, judging contest and both girls tied for high individual score, the telegram stated. The team of Hazel Saltmarsh and Joan Denny of the Oak Grove 4-H club was awarded first place in canning judging, Mr. Francis said.

Ten Jackson county 4-H club girls and three boys are entered in the fair, Mr. Francis attending as their supervisor. The girls entered 20 exhibits in home economics and registered for various competitions. The boys entered livestock judging contests.

Watermelon winners were selected on the scores shot in the first twenty-five bird, sixteen yard event, on the added bird yard, and included Jantzer, Croissant, Winkle, Hull, Thomas and Steiger.

During the shoot the club flag was placed at half mast in respect to Archie Parrott, veteran Oregon trapshooter, who died in Portland last week.

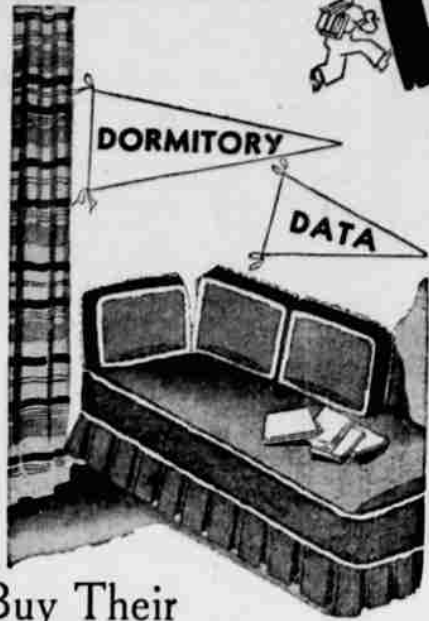
