

Ritz Brothers, Andrews Sisters in "Argentine Nights" at Craterian

PREMIERE GIVES MEDFORD INITIAL GLIMPSE OF FILM

Nine Song Numbers In Rollicking Show—Constance Moore In Lead.

The world's premiere showing of "Argentine Nights," co-starring the Ritz Brothers and the Andrews Sisters, opens today at the Craterian theater. It will play three days only.

Climaxing one of the most spectacular careers of any song trio in history, Patty, Maxene and LaVerne make their screen debut in the picture. Known to millions who have enjoyed their songs on phonograph records, radio and stage, the sisters have introduced dozens of hits—including the recent "Beer Barrel Polka." Now they embark on a new career—motion pictures—and, with their initial appearance in "Argentine Nights," are expected to become top stars in short order. They introduce four new songs in the film.

"Argentine Nights" shows the hilarious Ritzes taking a group of pretty girl entertainers into the pampas country, trying to make a hit the "South American Way" after their creditors from all 48 states hold a joint convention and force the boys' hand.

There are nine song numbers. The Andrews Sisters sing "Hit the Road," "The New Lick," "Oh, How He Loves Me" and "Rhumbogie." The Ritzes cut loose with "The Spirit of 77" (a travesty on section 77B of the bankruptcy act) and "Brooklynoga." Constance Moore sings "Once Upon a Dream" and "Hall of the Mountain Queen," the latter with a chorus. George Reeves, who shares the top romantic honors with Constance Moore, makes his debut in the film, singing "Amigo, We Go Riding Tonight," a gaucho number.

FOREST SERVICE SURVEY M'DONALD ROAD COMPLETED

Rogue River national forest headquarters yesterday announced completion of a location survey of the Wagner Creek road leading to the undeveloped McDonald basin which the Rogue Snowmen explored a couple of years ago and pronounced a winter sports area of exceptional potentialities.

the road right-of-way this winter. Involved is a 13-mile stretch running through timber land.

No grading will be done until the clearing has been completed, Mr. Janouch said. Progress of the work, he related, will depend upon the skill of the CCC men and the amount of road funds available. There are no forest road funds available for the work now and probably will not be until 1942, he added.

When the road is completed, the steepest grade will be 8 per cent, he said.

Avoiding much of the snow belt, the proposed road will join the Ashland loop road and thus lead to McDonald basin.
