And the inevitable and necessary refusal on the part of any self-respecting, liberty-loving race, to submit to such domination.

SO it becomes a fight to the finish and MUTUAL destruction!—in all likelihood the complete destruction of all civilization in Europe.

It's excusable at times, isn't it?—to close one's mind to such utterly inhuman and incredible facts; to escape momentarily from reality, when the reality formed by those facts places a large section of the human race on a plane considerably lower and less intelligent than the beast?

MANY HAVE SCURVY BUT DON'T KNOW IT. Dr. R. M. Overstreet reported 15 cases of scurvy in infants aged from 7 months, to 3 1/2 years, seven of them from rural districts.



None of them breast fed for longer than three weeks. A few spoonfuls of commercial canned tomato juice, or fresh orange juice, or fresh tomato juice, or any other fresh fruit juice, mixed with their milk daily, would have prevented the scurvy in these infants.

They were infants seen in hospital and out-patient clinic. Perhaps their parents were ignorant of the fundamental requirement of every infant for some such fruit juice daily or prevent scurvy. Fresh raw milk contains some vitamin C, perhaps enough to prevent scurvy in the infant if the cows are on pasture.

Boiled, sterilized, pasteurized, scalded canned, evaporated condensed milk contains little or none. Human breast milk contains considerable provided the mother's diet includes enough fresh fruit or fresh vegetables and greens.

But even the breast fed baby should receive some orange juice, tomato juice or other fresh fruit juice every day—or if only a teaspoonful, or two—mixed with a little water or mixed in the feeding if the baby is bottle fed.

It is the consensus of opinion today that an adequate intake of vitamin C, as in fresh fruit or factory canned fruit or tomato, fresh and canned vegetables, and especially such foods as cabbage, spinach, Brussels sprouts, kale and broccoli, as well as the less important onions, parsnips, turnips, cauliflower, potatoes, apples and bananas, is essential for the development of normal teeth and the preservation of healthy gums.

Probably many individuals whose diet for one reason or another is unduly restricted and whose daily intake of vitamin C is therefore inadequate, suffer from manifestations of scurvy which they ascribe to everything but scurvy. They assume the characteristic swelling and soreness in the joints, particularly the ankles, is "rheumatism." They think the discolorations,

are in the ranks of the Catholics. There are probably many reasons for this. One is the new foreign policy of the Vatican, which no longer runs parallel to that of the White House. Another is that a great many of New York's Irish think Jim Farley was treated badly by the president. And a third reason is that representatives of the church were incensed at the refusal of the army to exempt clerical students from conscription.

Since Mead is a well-known Catholic, replacement of him by a non-Catholic would create antagonisms.

It was also argued at the conference that Tammany would be unenthusiastic over a Roosevelt-La Guardia ticket, since La Guardia more than any other man was responsible for the breaking up of Tammany's control. But, as was pointed out, it is just as good sense to argue that Tammany would be delighted to have La Guardia in Washington rather than in New York.

La Guardia's administration friends have not abandoned their venture. And if the polls continue to show Willkie in the lead, their pleas may fall on more fertile ground. Yet it may be that no matter who the senatorial candidates, the presidential election will be unaffected. A recent private poll showed that only one of ten of his supporters in the last election remembered that they had voted for Senator Robert F. Wagner, one of the most popular men in the state.

The Vote in Maine. To the Editor:

A comparison between the September election in Maine for 1936 for United States senator, as compared with the election in 1940, was that in 1936 White, the Republican candidate for United States senator, received 158,068 votes and Brann, the Democratic candidate, received 153,420 votes, giving a majority for the Republican candidate of less than 5,000.

In 1940 the Republican candidate for United States senator in Maine received a majority of 45,000 votes.

Also, it is significant that in 1936 the Republican candidate for governor in Maine received 157,206 votes and the Democratic candidate received 139,745 votes, being less than 17,000 majority. This year the Republican candidate for governor gets a majority of 70,000 votes.
