

NEED SEVEN MEN TO FILL RANKS OF NATIONAL GUARD

Seven Enlistments Today
Bring Total to 33—Com-
pletion Expected Friday

With seven more recruits en-
rolled, Medford's National De-
fense committee at noon today
was within seven of the quota
of 40 men it set out to enlist
in the national guard here.

The new men enlisted were
Leland E. Jones, Ernest L. Log-
gins, Thomas J. Armstrong and
Elmo R. Sturgill, Medford, Wil-
liam B. Keizer, Central Point,
Earl V. Harnish, Eagle Point,
and Charles A. Platko, a Port-
age, Pa., youth who is being
discharged from the CCC here
so that he might enlist in the
national guard.

The seven enlistments today
brought the total to 33. It was
anticipated that filling of the
quota could be announced at
the meeting of the defense com-
mittee scheduled for 8 p. m. to-
morrow at the Jackson County
Chamber of Commerce.

Plan Medical Exam.

A medical board has been set
up to examine the officers and
men of the national guard units
in southern Oregon and the per-
sonnel of Company A and head-
quarters detachment will be ex-
amined some time next week.
The board is to begin its work
at Grants Pass Monday. It is
composed of Capt. H. T. Gentle,
surgeon of the Medford CCC
district, and 1st Lieut. Samuel
B. Osgood of Grants Pass and
George H. Merryman of Klamath
Falls, all officers of the medi-
cal corps reserve. Lieut. Col.
Robert P. Williams of Fort Ord,
Cal., is a member of the board
in so far as the examination of
officers is concerned. Capt.
Gentle is board president.

Company A and headquarters
company will be mobilized Mon-
day and leave for Camp Murray,
Wash., the following Monday.
Recruits are being enlisted only
for Company A as headquarters
detachment remains at its pres-
ent strength.

Beneka Endorses.

Merrill A. Beneka, chapter
commander of the Veterans of
Foreign Wars, today endorsed
the national guard enlistment
campaign. Mr. Beneka, a World
war veteran, is a member of
Medford's National Defense com-
mittee. He said:

"I enlisted in the Oregon na-
tional guard and obtained a
year's training that proved to
be a background of great value
when I went overseas."

"I took part in five major
battles and I can truthfully say
that my year of national guard
training made this actual com-
bat much easier."

"Any young man undecided
as to what to do, I'd advise to
enlist in Company A, 186th in-
fantry. Any young man who
does this will be with officers
and men he knows."

PHYSICIAN'S BAG TAKEN FROM CAR

Dr. C. I. Drummond reported
to city police yesterday that his
black physician's bag, valued
with its contents at from \$100
to \$150, was stolen out of his
automobile sometime Tuesday
night while it was parked in
front of a local hospital.

Dr. Drummond told police the
bag contained two hypodermic
syringes, about one and a half
grains of morphine and other
drugs, and various instruments.

The report of the theft was
the first received by police since
the epidemic of stolen physi-
cians' bags about a year and a
half ago. At that time over a
dozen bags were stolen in Med-
ford, Klamath Falls and Grants
Pass.

Grants Pass, Ore., Sept. 12.—
(AP)—The Oregon cavemen are
coming.

the American Legion in Boston

vention there, starting Septem-
ber 23.

For today Chief Bighorn Don
Cameron ordered ten fierce

to go to Boston, march in the
parades, and feed raw meat of
the saber-tooth tiger and warm
blood of the dinosaur to the new
national commander, whoever he
may be. The warriors, clad in
coyote and deerskins, will ac-
company Department Commad-
er A. P. Kelley and the Oregon
Legion delegation.

Chief Bighorn said the tribe
will also call on the great white
fathers at Washington who set
aside the caves years ago as a
national monument.

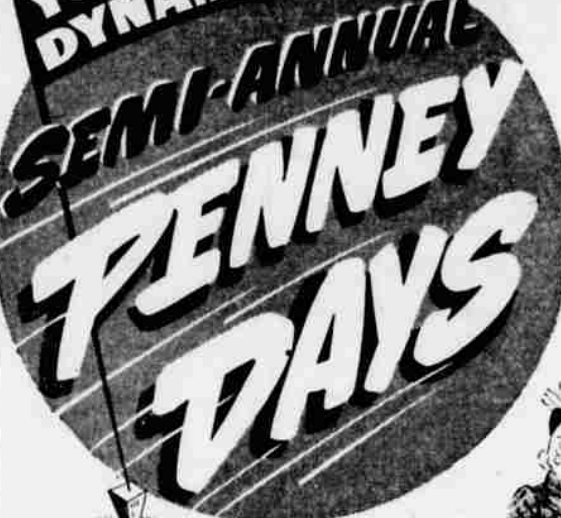
