

35 BODIES FOUND IN WRECKAGE OF POWDER FACTORY

Many Dead Believed Still in Explosion Wracked Plant—Cause Still Mystery

Kenvil, N. J., Sept. 13.—(AP)—The death list mounted to 35 today as rescue workers searched for additional bodies in the cooling ruins of the Hercules Powder company's plant which was leveled by a series of terrific explosions.

Dr. H. Raymond Mutchler, Morris county physician, set the death toll at 35 and said an unestimated number of bodies were still in the wreckage. Plant officials and state police earlier expressed belief the toll might reach 45 or 50 in the wake of yesterday's blast, one of the worst powder plant disasters in the nation's history.

Cause Undetermined

"It is highly likely we'll never be able to determine the cause of the explosion," said William G. Hunt, in charge of the company's explosives department. "The men immediately concerned are lost."

He said the death toll was 30 before Dr. Mutchler's announcement. The county physician said the revised list comprised bodies taken from the ruins and men who died in Dover General hospital.

The company manufactures smokeless powder and other explosives. It was engaged in fulfilling numerous national defense contracts. Today federal bureau of investigation agents were investigating possibilities of sabotage. In the last three months the company had received \$40,000,000 in contracts from the federal government.

The blast was of such intensity that the countryside was rocked for miles around. Reverberations were felt as far away as Danbury, Conn., 125 miles to the east. Thousands in surrounding districts believed there had been an earthquake.

WALKOUT ENDED IN PUGET PORTS

Tacoma, Sept. 13.—(AP)—Puget Sound waterfronts returned to near-normal today as longshoremen in Tacoma, Port Angeles and Anacortes ended a two week protest strike and "hot cargo" picket lines were dissolved at Seattle.

Termination of the strike brought contradictory statements from the west coast's rival waterfront leaders.

T. A. Thronson, coast ILA secretary, said the NLRB had promised to conduct hearings and allow the ILA to bargain for the ports where its members are in the majority. He declared the ILA had "beaten the NLRB" and termed it "one of our greatest victories."

At San Francisco, Harry Bridges, ILWU president, disputed Thronson's claim to victory and called on the NLRB to "immediately confirm or deny" it had "promised a re-hearing" to the ILA.
