

3 MORE RECRUITS WANTED TO FILL GUARD COMPANY

Four Previously Enlisted Fail in Physical Exam—Committee Meets Tonight

The national guard enlistment campaign here neared its close today with Medford's National Defense committee lacking only three of its quota of 40 recruits.

Enlistment of four more recruits was announced at noon today. The youths were Robert R. Ahrens and Donald J. Ahrens, brothers of Brownsboro,

and Jack Fruit and Roy L. Huson, Medford. They increased the total number of recruits enlisted in the campaign to 27. Four previously enlisted, however, were rejected last night when they failed to pass a physical examination.

Quota Set at 40

While the quota was set at 40, the actual number needed to bring company A, 186th infantry, up to mobilized strength was 28. Additional men were sought in order to have replacements for those who might fail in their medical examination. Since the enlistments have exceeded the immediate needs of the company, the defense committee considers that its campaign has attained its real goal. While enlisting will continue through tomorrow, recruiting headquarters at the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce will be closed tonight. Applicants tomorrow may report at the armory.

The defense committee will meet at the chamber of commerce at 8:00 tonight to wind up the recruiting campaign, first phase of its activities.

Company A and headquarters detachment will be mobilized at the armory Monday after being quartered in the armory for a week, the guardsmen will leave on the following Monday for a year of active duty at Camp Murray near Fort Lewis, Wash.

PERSHING PLEADS FOR FACT FACING AS WAR IMPERILS

World War Leader Receives Distinguished Service Cross on 80th Birthday.

Washington, Sept. 13.—(AP)—General John J. Pershing marked his 80th birthday anniversary today with a plea that America "face the facts" on an imminent danger of war.

Speaking over the radio just after receiving the Distinguished Service Cross in a White House ceremony, Pershing said: "Twenty-one years ago none of us dreamed that the calamity of war would come again to the world so soon and in such hideous and devastating form."

Imperative Warning

"But we must face the facts of today. Their warning call to America is shrill and imperative. The danger is imminent. The call comes not only to us who fought in the World War and to those who stood ready, but it comes to every patriotic citizen living under the protection of our great government."

"To meet it, we must pledge ourselves anew to fulfill our obligations to the nation, and again avow eternal devotion to the principles of liberty and justice upon which this nation rests."

The decoration Pershing received at the White House was for "extraordinary heroism in action against hostile fanatical Moros at Mount Baksak, Jolo, Philippine Islands, on June 15, 1913."

Refused in 1922

He refused the award in 1922 because he was then army chief of staff and thus had control of the decorations board, also, he was quoted as saying, because he did not think the action it recognized was up to the standard of the A. E. F. in 1917-18.

The award citation said Pershing, then a brigadier general, "personally assumed command of the assaulting line at the most critical period when only about 15 yards from the last Moro position. His encouragement and splendid example of personal heroism resulted in a general advance and the prompt capture of the hostile stronghold."

Also at the White House, the old soldier received from the new French ambassador, Gaston Henri-Haye, a personal letter from his old friend, Marshal Henry Petain, and a letter from the city of Versailles where stands a monument to Pershing.

CHAPMAN RALLIES TO REACH FINALS

Mamaroneck, N. Y., Sept. 13.—(AP)—Dick Chapman staged one of the greatest comebacks in the annals of amateur golf today by reaching the final round of the national amateur championship with a 3 and 2 victory over Wilford Wehrle of Chicago after being 5 down through the first nine holes.

In tomorrow's 36-hole final Chapman, who won the qualifying medal with two sub-par rounds, will meet 32-year-old W. B. (Duff) McCullough, Jr., of Philadelphia, who led from the first hole in the morning, and was 4 up at the halfway mark and marched on steadily to eliminate Ray Billows of Poughkeepsie, N. Y., twice a finalist, by 5 and 3.

BRITISH BOMBERS LASH KEY POINTS ON FRENCH COAST

London, Sept. 13.—(AP)—British bombers struck heavily last night at Le Havre, on the German held French coast, where the Nazi has been reported concentrating some of its most powerful units for an invasion of Britain, the air ministry announced tonight.

A German tanker and a supply ship were hit at Le Havre, the ministry said.

It also reported that a British balloon barrage had snared a German plane early today.

The ministry, reporting other night raids against key distribution centers at Osnabruck, Hamm, Schwerte, Ehrang and Brussels, asserted that these vital junctions and freight yards of western Germany, "must play an important part in any attempted invasion of Britain."

"Troops, reserves, equipment and supplies moving westwards to the channel ports from Germany must pass through one or the other of these key transportation points," it added.

DOUGHERTY HELD ON BAD CHECK CITATION

Winston T. Dougherty, 31, of Medford, charged with obtaining money by false pretenses, was being held in the county jail under \$500 bail today.
