

# CAKE ADDRESSES WILLKIE BACKERS IN MEETING HERE

### Bus May Be Chartered for Trip to Klamath to Hear Nominee Sunday Morning

More than 100 men and women heard Ralph Cake of Portland, Republican national committee man for Oregon, describe Wendell Willkie last night as "the most sincere" candidate to run for president in "many, many years."

Mr. Cake addressed a meeting of Jackson county precinct committeemen and women, Pro-America members, volunteer party workers and others interested in the party at Republican headquarters, 40 South Central avenue. The meeting was considered the most enthusiastic Republican gathering held here in years.

Mr. Cake dwelled upon the party's national convention theme that if democratic processes are to be preserved, the country must have a change in administration this year.
