

HINMANS HIGH IN EXAMINATION FOR NAVY AIR TRAINING

Although it wasn't Medford's Bob Hinman who passed the severe examination at Sand Point naval station near Seattle for navy pilot training, with the highest grade in history, it was a Hinman, all right, and at the same time it was announced that Bob, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry S. Hinman of 336 South Holly street, had passed the test with a "very high" grade.

According to an Associated Press report from Seattle, Thomas Hinman of Portland, no relation to Bob, had passed the test February 21 with the highest grade in history. Comdr. Bert H. Creighton, senior member of the naval aviation selection board at Sand Point, told the A. P. that Bob Hinman stood "very high" as regards the examination, which he took Wednesday.

Bob, a 1935 Medford high school graduate, has been attending Willamette university for the past three years and will be graduated June 7. He will report at Sand Station for cadet training July 16. Cadets spend about six weeks at Sand Point, then are transferred to Pensacola, Fla.
