Ask Wage Ceiling

Portland, June 28.—(AP)—Northwest Oregon lumbermen said today that if a price ceiling were placed on west coast lumber, labor costs and long prices also should be stabilized.

Portland, Ore., June 28.—(AP)—A federal court jury convicted Frank C. Hiller, 30, and Harold H. Conner, 31, of kidnapping today.

Federal Judge James A. Fee said he would sentence the men Thursday. Motions of law will be given additional consideration, meantime.

The trial was notable in that it was the first time women ever sat on a federal court jury in Oregon—there were six of them.

Hiller and Conner were accused of abducting an 18-year-old girl in Portland and transporting her across the state line to a point east of Vancouver, Wash.

HEAT OVERCOMES 50 AT HIGH MASS

Rochester, N. Y., June 28.—(AP)—Fifty persons among 12,000 attending a pontifical high mass in the city's International league baseball park today were overcome by 95-degree heat.

In addition, 150 choir boys participating in the observance of the mass—part of a Catholic students' mission crusade convention—were given emergency treatment.

Back Soviet Aid

Los Angeles, June 28.—(AP)—The Associated Farmers of California board of directors is on record as favoring all possible aid to Russia "to the extent of placing all nazis in concentration camps and sending to Moscow all communists in the United States."

NOTED DEAD

Hollywood, June 28.—(AP)—Richard Carle, the tall, thin, grey-haired character actor with the high-pitched, quizzical voice, died today, but his best friend is carrying on for him in the movies.

Carle, 69, suffered a heart attack a week ago while working in a new Deanna Durbin picture. His partner in dozens of stage and screen shows, Walter Catlett, replaced him.

Carle was prominent on the stage for 30 years as a comedian, playwright and composer.
