

TWO JOIN HOGAN IN OWNERSHIP OF HALLEY BUILDING

Partnership Is Formed With
Louis Serruys and Murry
Schoolman; Form Plans.

M. N. Hogan today announced that he had disposed of part of his interest in the Halley building on South Central avenue at Eighth street to Louis E. Serruys of Klamath Falls and Murry P. Schoolman of Burlington, Cal.

Mr. Hogan bought the property a short time ago from the Addie Halley estate. A court order confirming the sale was signed recently by Circuit Judge H. K. Hanna. The Rev. L. F. Belknap was administrator of the estate. Mr. Hogan has managed the property since June 1 and said he would continue his management of it.

Mr. Hogan said that he, Mr. Serruys and Mr. Schoolman will own and operate the property as a partnership known as the Crater Hotel. The second floor has long been used as a lodging place while business places have occupied the downstairs. Known formerly as the Palace hotel, the property will now be called the Crater hotel.

No First Floor Plans
No plans have been made regarding the first floor, Mr. Hogan indicated. Four store fronts on South Central avenue remain unoccupied but Mr. Hogan said he has received so many inquiries about the premises that he has lost track of them. No leases have been given but there may be an announcement shortly regarding the two spaces on the corner, he said. The remaining first floor space is occupied by the Brainerd Studio and Camera shop, Helen's Beauty shop, Roseborough barber shop and the Yellow Cab company.

Upstairs Renovated
Since Mr. Hogan took over the management the second floor has been completely renovated, painted and kalsomined. Floors have been sanded and painted and linoleum has been laid in some of the rooms. A new shower and wash room is being installed and when completed will contain four showers, five wash stands and other facilities, Mr. Hogan related. New gas water-heating equipment has been ordered and will be installed in the shower room to insure ample hot water for the building, he said.

Sixty-four inner spring mattresses, 24 Simmons springs and several new beds have been received and are now being put in the rooms of the hotel. New blankets and bed linen have been ordered and will be placed in use as fast as they are received, Mr. Hogan stated. The hotel will be operated for men only, Mr. Hogan emphasized.

PLANE SCHEDULE CHANGES SEPT. 1

Four schedule changes here effective September 1 were announced today by United Air Lines. Two of the changes were attributed to resumption of service at Red Bluff, Cal., this stop having been out since last winter. The other two changes were made to avoid convergence of too many planes at Portland at the same time.

The changes, effective Monday, are:

Northbound: The Mainliner now arriving at 12:02 p. m. will arrive at 12:18 and depart at 12:23 p. m.; the plane now arriving at 3:43 p. m. will arrive at 3:58 and leave at 4:03 p. m.

Southbound: The Mainliner now arriving at 5:52 p. m. will arrive at 5:37 and depart at 5:42 p. m.; the plane now arriving at 11:47 p. m. will arrive at 11:32 and depart at 11:37 p. m.

The other five schedules will remain as they are now.

The northbound plane to arrive here at 12:18 p. m. will stop at Red Bluff as will the southbound plane to leave here at 11:37 p. m.
