

WOMAN EXPLAINS BEE-LINE CAUSE

Indianola, Miss., Sept. 5—(AP)—The curbstone sitters club ad-

BRITISH REPORT 'CERTAIN' SINKING OF ITALIAN SHIP

London, Sept. 5—(AP)—A large Italian liner of a type known to be serving for troop transport—believed to be the 23,633-ton Duilio—has been torpedoed "and almost certainly sunk" in a series of British successes in the Mediterranean, the admiralty announced today.

The big ship was attacked while sailing with two other large passenger ships off the coast of Italy, the admiralty said in a communique announcing two other Mediterranean attacks on axis shipping.

In yet another engagement the admiralty reported that a 10,000-ton cruiser was hit by torpedoes and seriously damaged by a British submarine in an attack on "an enemy naval force" (presumably Italian) between Sicily and Italy proper.

A loaded tanker was torpedoed and sunk from an axis convoy off Sicily, and in the same group of vessels the 4,971-ton Italian supply ship Aquitania was severely damaged by torpedoes.

In the central Mediterranean an axis supply ship of "about 8,000 tons" was torpedoed and sunk by a British submarine, the admiralty said.

The enemy naval force was reported encountered close to the Straits of Messina.

BUSINESS GAINS OVER LAST YEAR

New York, Sept. 5—(AP)—Buying in retail stores entered the fall selling season this week with vigorous demand for most all lines of merchandise, and sales volume averaged 23 to 28 per cent above a year ago for the country as a whole, Dun & Bradstreet reported today.

Most stores found business gains over a year ago well maintained despite the fact that, at this time last year there was a strong upturn.

"Trade apparently took in its stride the new credit curbs affecting 25 classes of consumers' goods," the agency said. "In the first few days after the regulation became effective, appliance sales experienced no perceptible let-down."

"Furniture volume declined, but by no more than the expected amount, as promotional emphasis shifted from August sales of home furnishings to fall style goods."

"In women's apparel, furs continued far in the lead, with coats and suits also moving well and dress sales beginning to pick up more briskly."

BABY TOOTS HORN, PAPA HELD, FREED

New Britain, Conn., Sept. 5—(AP)—George Nicholas, Jr., aged 18 months, was having a good time blowing the horn on daddy's automobile. Neighbor Raymond Hart, a policeman on night duty, was trying to sleep—and not having a very good time.

He and George, Sr., came out at the same time to see about the noise. There followed an argument and the arrest of George, Sr., on a breach-of-the-peace charge. But Judge Elias T. Ringrose said horn-blowing was a habit with children, and dismissed the complaint. The judge is the father of six.

FOREST FIRES IN STATE DECLINE

Salem, Sept. 5—(AP)—Asserting that the "keep Oregon green" campaign is a success, Governor Charles A. Sprague said today that only 7,659 acres of state and private forest lands have been burned over this year.

There have been only 312 man-caused fires, against a normal of 700. There were 524 fires caused by lightning, or 63 per cent of the total number. The normal figure is 15 per cent.

Lightning caused more than 90 per cent of the damage.
