Independence, Kas., Sept. 12. (P)—Alfred Hall knows how it feels to be hit by a haystack.

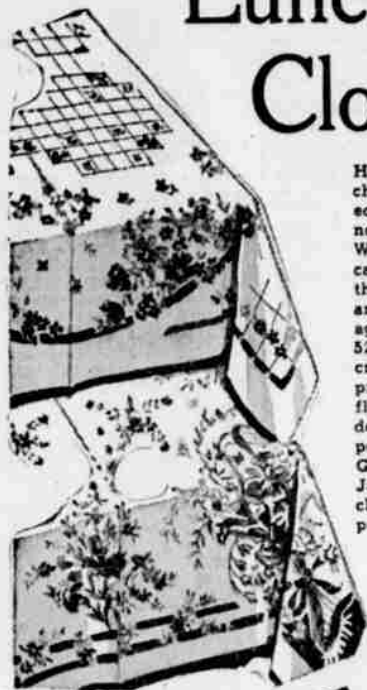
A truck lost its load of alfalfa just as Hall's car passed it. It buried the car and broke the windshield but Hall was unhurt. A passenger suffered minor cuts.

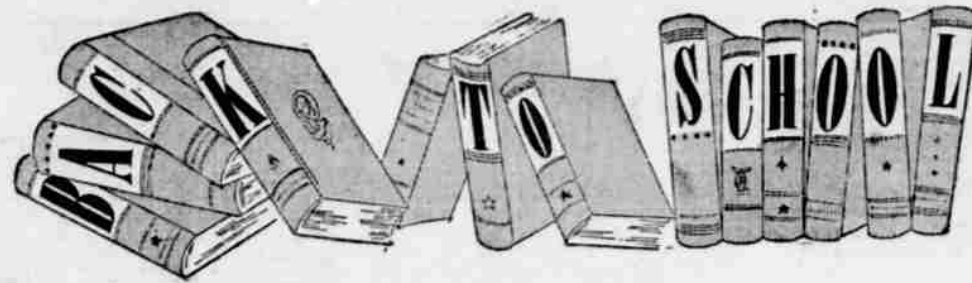
