

CANTONMENT SITE EYED BY OFFICER RULING SHIPMENTS

Col. Henry Akin this morning looked over the site and drawings of the proposed Beagle-Antelope army cantonment with a view to the matter of transporting supplies and equipment to the camp.

Col. Akin was interested in supply problems, for if the cantonment should be constructed one of his jobs would be the shipping of equipment and supplies to the camp.
