

MANY NEW DOLLS MAKE APPEAL TO YOUNGER KIDDIES

"Little Mickey" is one of the newest little boy dolls dressed in real corduroy overalls and wearing a matching "beanie" hat and a little boy's basque shirt.

"Butch" is another little boy toddler type doll with real hair, wearing a basque shirt and cotton overalls.

The newest "Dy-Dee" dolls have flexible ears that look really human and turned up noses that may be cleaned with cotton tipped Q-tips.

A Chinese character doll with a miniature replica of herself in quilted chintz pajamas is a novel addition to the doll stock.

Little Lady dolls or the "teen age" type are fashion conscious

and feature furs and feathers with their formal party dresses.

The "Bond Baby doll" is used to promote National Defense bonds. This attractively dressed baby doll carries a Defense Bond album with a 25c defense stamp already pasted in it. The idea is to encourage little children to start saving defense stamps.

A Refugee doll is an appealing new style dressed in simple cotton print with white apron and kerchief on her head. She carries her complete change of clothing in a kerchief tied on her arm.

"Little Genius" a lovable baby doll with latex arms and legs that feel almost human.

"Sleepy Head," the favorite cuddly doll of last year is again a favored gift. Soft fur fabric body in pastel colors and slide fastened opening down the back to use as a concealed pocket.

The quaint McGuffy doll with a miniature straw hat is the same character doll which has been popular for several years. It is now featured in miniature size.

From the animal kingdom there is the Victory Lion: a brown mohair and tan brushed cloth with a V for victory on the back.
