Old Roads—Improvement in Oregon highways in the past 18 years is vividly shown by an illustrated story in the Oregonian of June 15, 1924. SCOUTS TO START GATHERING PAPER COMING SATURDAY

A city-wide collection of waste paper begins Saturday, with Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts attempting to cover the entire community for the first time in the salvage effort. Medford has been divided into districts and each district assigned to certain Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops. Some of the districts are large and the problems of handling large quantities of waste paper will not be easily solved. According to word from the Boy Scouts and the Girl Scout headquarters every effort is being made to work out a smooth and continuing plan for collection. The paper is needed for remaking into paperboard cartons for munitions and foodstuffs. Funds raised by sale of the paper will be used by the individual Boy and Girl Scout troops for their own needs, summer camping, defense stamps, etc.

Householders and business establishments can be very helpful if they will observe the following simple rules:

1. Save newspapers and magazines separately and if possible tie them in bundles convenient for handling.
2. Place scrap paper and small boxes (flattened) in a larger carton so that they can be carried away.
3. Keep the paper in a dry place until called for.
