WRECKED PLANES CLAIM 17 LIVES

Spokane, Wash., Jan. 16.—(AP)—An army bombing plane on a routine flight Wednesday afternoon crashed and burned 13 miles southeast of Boise, Idaho, killing the nine men aboard, second air force headquarters said today.

San Bernardino, Calif., Jan. 16.—(AP)—Bodies of eight members of a B26 army bomber crew have been recovered and the ninth is believed to be underneath wreckage of the plane in the vicinity of Cajon Pass.

Deputy Coroner Edward P. Doyle said a severed arm, identified from a finger ring as from the body of Pvt. Vernon H. Englebrecht of Fort Wayne, Ind., was found in the wreckage. Bodies of the eight other victims were thrown clear.

The annual meeting of the Rogue River Jersey Cattle club will be held at 1:30 p. m. Saturday, Jan. 17, at the court house in Medford.

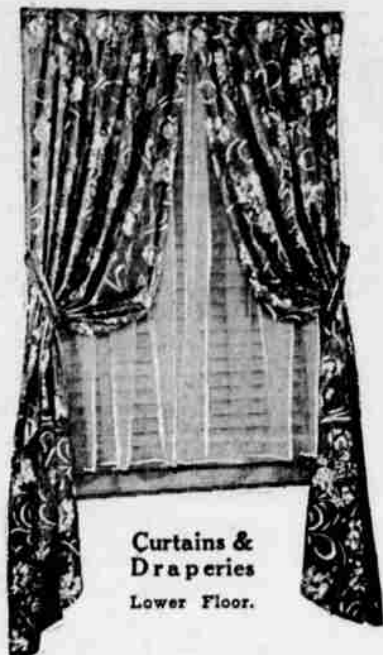
Election of officers, appointment of special committees and general business of the club will be features of the afternoon session.
