

BELL STUDIO TO OPEN HERE WITH BOWMAN MANAGER

Bell Studios, new photographic studio at 109 East Main street in this city, will open Saturday, according to an announcement by Dace Bowman. The new studio, under the management of Mr. Bowman, will specialize in hand painted portraits in oil. Latest type Cooper-Hewitt lightings and professional Hollywood backgrounds will be employed by Bell Studios, with emphasis upon theatrical poses and speed film for photographs of children and tiny babies.

"War times have always been known as good times for the photograph business," Bowman

said today in commenting upon the establishment of new studios in this city. "It brings about a natural exchange of pictures of loved ones leaving and sends a message home that can be displaced only by a personal call." The government in a bulletin just before Christmas asked the "folks back home" to send the boys in the service pictures for Christmas and this appeal automatically created an enormous Christmas for all the photographs throughout the country in itself.

Dace Bowman, one of the owners and the general manager of the Bell Studios in this city, comes from Klamath Falls where he has managed a similar studio for some time.
