CARY GRANT HAS SUPPORTING ROLE IN DRAMATIC HIT

Nigel Bruce In Cast—Film Brings Miss Fontaine Top Laurels.

SCHOOL GIRL SPY GETS FIVE YEARS

New York, March 21—(AP)—Lucy Boehm, 19-year-old high school girl, who said she "found espionage lots of fun," was sentenced today to five years in federal women's reformatory at Alderson, W. Va., by Federal Judge Henry W. Goddard.

Judge Goddard also sentenced Carl Herman Schroetter, 48-year-old skipper of a Miami, Fla., fishing boat, to 10 years imprisonment.

Both pleaded guilty to participation in the espionage ring headed by Kurt Frederick Ludwig, master Nazi spy, who was sentenced to 20 years imprisonment recently.
