

DR. GORDON TALKS ON CHINA'S NEEDS AT LIONS MEETING

Dr. Erma Gordon, state director of China relief, addressed the Lions club luncheon-meeting at the Hotel Medford, Wednesday, on affairs in China and their relation to the war. Dr. Gordon pointed out that the stubborn and relentless opposition the Chinese are offering to the Japanese, is keeping a Japanese army of about a million men away from the conflict in the south sea.

Dr. Gordon pointed out that, due to Japanese invasion, a tremendous strain had been placed on the living conditions of the interior provinces. Almost fifty million people have been forced to the interior; there have been 300,000 child casualties, and almost five million adults have sacrificed their lives, since the invasion of China began, said Dr. Gordon.

Accompanying Dr. Gordon, was C. E. (Pop) Gates, Medford chairman of the present China relief drive, who stated \$1 would buy food for a child for a whole month in China—that \$20 would clothe and feed a child for a year.

The club voted to sponsor Troop 3, Boy Scouts, for the ensuing fiscal year. President Eston Humphrey stated that committeemen would be named immediately to work with the scoutmaster of Troop 3.

A highlight of Dr. Gordon's visit was a round-table discussion, in which she answered questions about Germany, where she resided, both before and after Hitler came into power.

Highlights of the discussion were: "The system of enslavement is more complete today than ever before in the history of the world—methods of punishment are more effective; whole families suffer for the offense of one person. Germany is stronger than we think; German nationals all over the world contribute financially and work toward accomplishment of the Hitlerian goal. The German youth is trained from the time he is 10 years old to become a soldier; he is taught that the German people are invincible—that, not in thousands of years has Germany been invaded and that every worthwhile thing accomplished can be traced to German origin."
