

LOCAL FIRMS GAIN MERIT AWARD FOR PAYROLL SAVINGS

Citation Given Where 90
Per Cent Or More Em-
ployees Join Defense Effort

Announcement was made to-day by W. A. Gates, chairman of the Jackson County war savings staff, that firms and organizations of this area would be issued an official certificate for merit award for participation in payroll savings of 90 per cent or more. The participation is on the basis of number of employees and has nothing to do with the amount of money involved. Mr. Gates stated. Unions and fraternal groups are also entitled to this recognition.

Authorization to purchase an official Treasury flag will further be given to firms qualifying for the certificate of merit award. These flags, available in various sizes, may be secured at little cost and displayed as an emblem of honor by concerns whose employees have shown their patriotism and thrift by buying war defense bonds and stamps.

Will Canvass All

A systematic program which will reach every industry of this area and will make both employers and employees bond and stamp minded has been launched by the industrial bond sales committee of this county, headed by Carl Y. Tengwald. Among the concerns already qualifying for the certificate of merit award and entitled to display the treasury flag are: Mann's Department store, Burelson's, Medford Domestic Laundry, George A. Hunt theatres, Jacque Lenox shop, Littrell Parts company, the California Oregon Power company, Gates and Lydiard's Groceries, Medford Lodge 1188, B.P.O.E., Pierce Auto Freight Lines and Swift and Company.

A check of other Medford concerns is now being made by Mr. Tengwald's committee to determine whether or not they qualify for recognition from the U. S. Treasury Department. Among the 100 per cent concerns are Swift and Company, according to T. R. Reece, manager of the local plant. All employees are participating in the payroll allotment plan on a voluntary basis. Pierce Auto Freight Lines was one of the first large organizations in this area to go "all out" for war and defense savings, local war savings staff officials stated.
