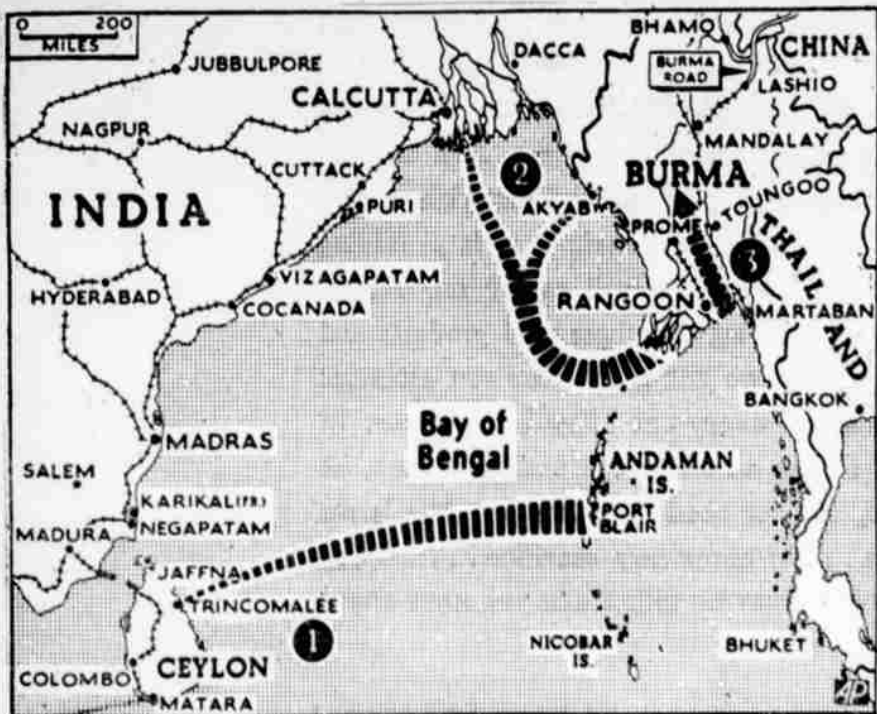

Japs Score In Bengal Area



Enemy planes bombed Trincomalee (1), British naval base on the island of Ceylon. Japs claimed a sea force had landed on the Burmese coast and that there were reports that Japanese submarines were operating (2) in the Ganges estuary. Jap reinforcements continued moving up in the Prom and Tounghoo sector (3).

U. S. NAT'L BANK DEPOSITS HIGHER

In its statement to the United States Comptroller of Currency as of April 4 the United States National Bank, which has one of its important units in this city, shows a higher mark in deposits than at any time of previous call, \$197,112,447.19. This mark has added approximately 25 millions more in deposits than on the same date in 1941. Loans and discounts show a gain of approximately \$43,305,554.21. Total resources as of this call are \$209,672,920.73 against the total of

a year ago of \$184,094,626.41. These gains, according to officials of the United States National Bank, are in spite of heavy investment in war bonds by people in all walks of life, indicating that there is a pronounced tendency to increase savings beyond the normal rate.

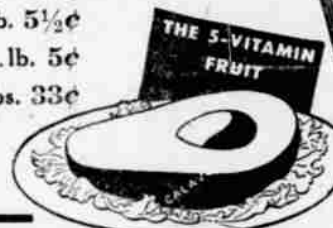
