Hitler's Life Is Subject Film Now On Holly's Screen

A weapon that Hitler fears far more than any article of war is the sensational expose of his life—"After Mein Kampf," which opens for tonight and tomorrow night only at the Holly theatre. 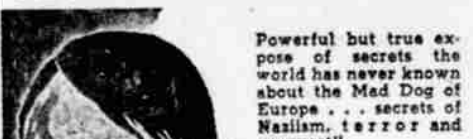
