With Henry Fonda and Olivia DeHaviland heading the cast and Joan Leslie, Jack Carson, Eugene Pallette and Hattie McDaniel in chief supporting roles, "The Male Animal," labeled as one of the most rib-tickling comedies of the current season, opens a three-day run today at the Craterian theatre.

Fonda is shown as a genial professor, more on the mild side and genuinely fond of his wife, Olivia. She however, has her troubles in getting him out of difficulties arising from his wholly unusual sense of right and wrong. She also likes to have her fun.

The fun is provided when an old classmate (and ex-football hero) portrayed by Jack Carson, comes back for the big game. He and Olivia become a bit more friendly than old acquaintanceship warrants—at least from Fonda's point of view—and another trouble is piled on the professor's back.

The situations become more breezy and humorously involved as the picture progresses, building up to a climax that is said to be one the best laugh-provoking bits in pictures.
