

FIREWORKS UNDER COMPLETE TABOO

Salem, June 5.—(AP)—All law enforcement officers in Oregon were ordered by Governor Charles A. Sprague to arrest any person who sells or uses fireworks. The governor cited an order by Lieut. Gen. John L. DeWitt, commanding the western defense area, prohibiting the sale and use of fireworks. This order, the governor said, carries the same force and effect of law. "It should be noted," the governor said, "that the sale or use of fireworks, firecrackers and even cap pistols is prohibited throughout the entire state, in cities, towns, as well as in all areas outside incorporated cities. Customary roadstands cannot be operated."

Coos County Added To Rental Control

San Francisco, June 5.—Coos county, Oregon, was added by the office of price administration to its list of defense-rental areas yesterday.

More than 89 million persons are now affected by the designation throughout the country. Price Administrator Leon Henderson recommended that rents in the Coos and 23 other newly designated areas be reduced to levels prevailing March 1, 1942.

Portland, June 5.—(AP)—War-important highway improvement contracts totaling \$1,300,000 were let by the state highway commission yesterday, but a major project in the Camp Adair area was rejected on a bid of \$522,918.

2 hot large sized biscuits

1 cup creamed salmon or other fish

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 hard-cooked egg, sliced

1/4 teaspoon celery salt

1/4 teaspoon paprika

Split hot biscuits. Blend ingredients, pour over biscuits. Replace tops and serve immediately.

Piquant Beets

1 tablespoon bacon fat

1 teaspoon minced onion

1 teaspoon minced parsley

1 cup diced cooked beets

2 tablespoons vinegar

1/4 teaspoon sugar

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 cup strained apple sauce (unsweetened)
2-3 cup raisins
2 cups flour
1 teaspoon soda

1 teaspoon baking powder
Cream fat and sugar. Add rest of ingredients and beat a minute. Pour into shallow pan lined with waxed paper. Bake 30 minutes in moderate oven. Serve warm or cold. To make sauce, add water to sliced apples and cook, covered, until apples are soft. Press through strainer.

Apple Butter Whipped Cream top- per is very good on plain cake. Mix half as much apple butter as whip- ped cream and spread on top fresh white, yellow or spice cake. Serve promptly. The combination will al- so work with gingerbread or any other victory (low on sugar) cake.
