

Churchill Arrival Inspiring Sign of Allied Alertness

British Premier Churchill's arrival for another conference with President Roosevelt is an inspiring indication of Allied alertness and coordination of effort at this crucial moment when decisive military actions are on the fire.

It's natural that speculation over the opening of a second front should mushroom up overnight, in view of the pressure from Moscow and the recent Allied agreement on "the urgent task of creating a second front in Europe in 1942." Without doubt this burning question will figure in the Roosevelt-Churchill talks, but that can't be the sole subject for consideration, since there are numerous other vital problems which warrant this unexpected but no very surprising meeting.

China's Position Seen Most Serious

For instance: (1) China's position is probably more serious than it has been since the outbreak of the Sino-Japanese conflict, and Chungking is urging immediate Allied aid. (2) The threat of a Jap attack on Russia is ever present, its materialization likely depending on a successful development of Hitler's offensive in eastern Soviet. High Chinese sources today said they thought the Japanese figured on striking Siberia in July.

(3) On the credit side, the fierce losses we inflicted on the Jap navy and air fleet at Midway, coupled with the Nipponese defeat in the Coral Sea, have so weakened the enemy striking power in the Pacific that a realignment of Allied strategy may now be possible.

(4) But on the debit page we have the heavy shipping losses in the Atlantic due to the unrestricted Nazi submarine campaign—certainly a matter of much concern at a time when speedy transportation of war supplies is urgent.

(5) The foremost questions, however, revolve about that great summer offensive which Hitler is trying to bring into being, for the outcome of the war most likely hinges on that. Into this picture, of course, fits the matter of that second front—whether it is desirable or feasible at this time.

Hitler's Drive Stalled By Reds

Hitler's preliminary efforts to get his big drive into full swing have been unsuccessful in the face of a really magnificent Russian resistance and counter-attack. However, nobody is naive enough to believe that the Nazi chief has shown his full power, or anything like it. He still holds in reserve a vast army of fresh troops and mountainous material, including great air strength. All that is going to be brought into action soon, and then hell will begin to pop.

WOULD CALL OFF FAIRS, CONCLAVES

Washington, June 19—(AP)—The government asked today that all state and county fairs, non-essential conventions, meetings and group tours be postponed until the war is over.

Joseph B. Eastman, defense transportation director, made the appeal and said that if civilians restricted their use of trains and buses the government might not have to take direct control over travel.

In asking postponement of fairs, Eastman said farmers should not be encouraged to use tires for such non-essential purposes.

Attendance at meetings connected with the war effort, he

said, should be skeletonized. "Along the lines of the example set by the American Legion in its forthcoming convention."
