A class in electric welding is open to 15 women according to announcement today by E. H. Hedrick, city school superintendent. The call has been issued for 15 women to be trained within the next three months for welding in shipyards.

Among requirements are good health, able to stand heavy work, be 18 to 50 years of age. Women interested are asked to register immediately at the city school superintendent's office in the city hall.

Women will be referred to the day classes which men cannot fill due to employment. The classes meet six days a week at the high school from 6:15 until 9:30 a. m. or 2:30 until 5:45 p. m. Instructors are Ed Leaming and Van Galder. Hedrick said there is an increasing need for women in defense activities.
