Long Investigation of Roxy
Ann Properties With Aim
of Furnishing Cantonment

Coal mining properties in the Roxy Ann area, are being and have been for the past year thoroughly investigated by the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce with the view of reopening them to produce fuel sumption, a chamber spokesman for Camp White and local con-said today.

Although the quality of the coal available in this territory is not of the highest, the spokesman said it was of a sufficiently good grade for most purposes and that plans were being made to develop the deposits.

In a communication to the Mail Tribune, printed yesterday, J. Little of Portland claimed that an old mine four miles south of Medford would produce 50,000 tons of coal if put into operation. Little, who wrote that he formerly managed the coal properties near Roxy Ann for the Southern Oregon Gas company, claimed that a three-foot vein existed in the mine, which was developed over 45 years ago by his father for the Southern Pacific company.

Seven Measures On Ballot in November For Voter Decision

Salem, July 1.—(AP)—Seven measures will be on Oregon's general election ballot in November, the state elections division said today.

Tomorrow is the deadline for filing completed initiative measures, but the division said it did not expect any more to be filed.

Measures include:

Initiative providing that all state income tax revenues in excess of \$7,750,000 a year shall be used for school purposes.

A proposed constitutional amendment increasing legislators' pay from \$3 a day for 40 days to \$8 a day for 50 days.

A proposed constitutional amendment repealing the article of the constitution providing for the rural credits loan fund.

A proposed constitutional amendment providing that gasoline taxes shall be used exclusively for roads.

A proposed constitutional amendment to permit the legislature to restore voting rights to persons convicted of felonies.

prohibit net fishing in coastal streams and bays.

A referendum to tax cigarettes at two cents per package, the proceeds to be used for old age assistance and vocational education.

Seattle, July 1.—(AP)—A Seattle dentist, with an eye for invention as well as cavities, has devised a one-shot hypodermic syringe which he foresees as a life-saver for wounded men on the battlefield. It's a cellulose-wrapped automatic device, to be used and discarded like a paper cup.

Dr. Ralph Huber, the creator, explains that its great virtue is in eliminating the time-consuming process of sterilization and the danger of infection from improperly sterilized needles.
