

G. P. MAYOR QUILTS AFTER BRIEF AND TURBULENT REIGN

W. E. Moore Tenders Resignation—Councilman J. K. Manuel Acting Mayor.

Grants Pass, July 31.—(P)—Joe Wharton, sporting goods dealer and long active in local civic affairs, today was third Grants Pass mayor in five months.

W. E. Moore, elected by the council in March to fill the vacancy left by the death of James A. Slover, resigned Wednesday night. Wharton was elected by the council Thursday afternoon.

Grants Pass, July 31.—(Spl.)—W. E. Moore, mayor of Grants Pass since March, resigned at a special council meeting Wednesday night.

Outlining his conception of the civilian defense program to include full authority of the mayor over all departments of city government, he said he was unable to realize his aims and therefore retired.

Moore has been a member of the county defense council, appointed by the governor, by virtue of his position as mayor. A vote four to one accepted the resignation.

In his short administration since his election by the council to fill the vacancy left by the death of James A. Slover, Moore has had a turbulent administration.

A month ago he secured the resignation of Police Chief Ben Graybill and placed Homer Grable, fire chief, on probation, charging they sought to influence the council toward a pay increase. Graybill said the dispute was over making reports.

Moore also was involved in a dispute with Councilman Sam McConnell about authority in direction of the fire department. McConnell is chairman of the fire committee.

Last week he asked the council to grant him the right to supervise and question employees subservient to or critical of civilian defense or the city administration. The council shelved the proposal at that time and did not bring it up again Wednesday night.

DEVICES WOODEN TIRE AND WHEEL

Rochester, N. Y.—(U.P.)—A 62-pound wooden wheel and tire that rumbles on brick but "purrs like a pneumatic on macadam," has been devised by Ernest G. Munch, Sr., 80, of suburban Ionia, who says the tire showed no wear after 125 miles and appears good for "at least 10,000 miles."

Himself amazed at the ease with which it takes corners, Munch admitted that he intended the gadget primarily as a "sparer," though claiming there's no reason why a set of four wouldn't serve admirably for speeds of 20-25 miles per hour, with a maximum of 40 miles per hour.

Turned on a huge lathe, the wheel-tire combination consists of layers of a strong, light wood cemented together with waterproof glue to form a plywood having equal strength in all directions. Now, Munch is working on improvements, hoping to incorporate some metal parts to reduce the over-all weight.

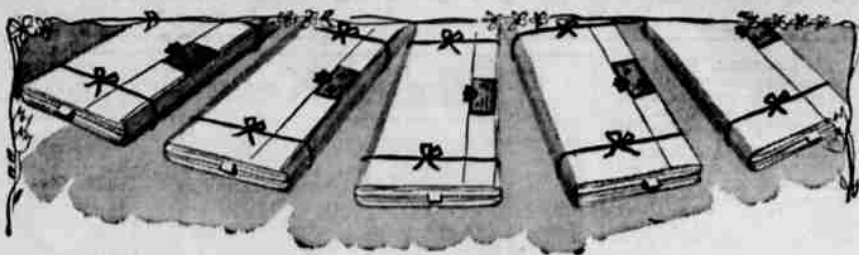
