INVITE PUBLIC TO SEE HOW SOLDIERS NEGOTIATE ROGUE

Starting at 5:15 a. m. Thursday and continuing throughout the day, units of the 91st Infantry Division at Camp White will stage a series of practice crossings of Rogue river just below Bybee bridge at the camp's swimming area.

Crossings will be made by swimming or ferrying, with such equipment as the unit commanders may prescribe. Ropes will be strung across the stream for those who can't swim, and it was emphasized that every soldier in the division, not hospitalized, would make the crossing.

Equipment to be ferried across will probably include a number of "peeps," which will be wrapped in canvas and "floated" to the other bank, Major Charles H. Gerhardt's headquarters announced.

The public is invited to witness the crossing maneuvers, which will be from the north to the south bank.
