LABOR TROUBLES IN TACOMA MAY CLOSE UP STORES

Tacoma, Aug. 8. — (P) — With the announcement that 5,000 defense industry jobs were open in Tacoma with no takers, many retail stores, now closed by labor strike, may not open their doors again for the duration of the war.

This fear was expressed by the heads of several large store owners and by union officials when 30 retail stores, including all department stores and most of the concerns handling furniture, ready to wear, shoes and variety goods, failed to open for business today.

The stores, all members of the Industrial Conference board, were observing an agreement made recently "whereby any action against one of the members was considered a strike against all members."

Employees walked out of several stores when they heard wage increase negotiations in progress for two months had failed.
