

TRAVELERS' AID REPRESENTATIVE IS SOUGHT HERE

Influx of Population Brings
Problems is Word at
Meeting of USO Council.

Medford USO council recommended that a representative of the Travelers' Aid be sent to this city to assist in caring for many problems which will arise from the influx of population resulting from the establishment of Camp White. Other USO business was also handled at the regular USO council session at the center on West Main street yesterday afternoon.

The Traveler's Aid case worker, it was explained, would assist in caring for girls who become stranded in the vicinity, those seeking assistance in personal problems and housing and act as an information and travel service bureau among its many duties.

Resignation of John Moffat as vice chairman of the USO council and permanent USO fund campaign chairman was accepted by the board in view of his many pressing duties.

Mrs. Dolph Phipps, USO chairman, announced appointment of a finance committee to include George Frey, Sam Colton and the Rev. H. G. Gardner.

Reports were read from various USO volunteer committees followed by a monthly report by Mrs. Helen Small, USO director and Mrs. Penny Fontaine, USO program director. Mrs. Small said that over 10,000 persons in southern Oregon military and civilian, had participated in the USO program during July.
