

ROAD TO VICTORY FULL OF STONES

Camp Hood, Tex., Sept. 18.—(U.P.)—Undersecretary of War Robert P. Patterson, sharply criticizing the few Americans "who think they can coast to victory with business and pleasure as

usual," warned today that an all-out victory cannot be achieved with any compromise in the war effort. "There are still a few Americans who think they can win a war surrounded by all modern conveniences," he said. "It can't be done."

San Francisco, Sept. 18.—(U.P.)—Col. Karl R. Bendtsen, chief of the wartime civil control administration, said today the next contingent of Japanese to be transferred from the Santa Anita, Cal., assembly center, will begin moving Sunday to the Rohrer relocation center, Desha county, Arkansas.

Approximately 4,500 Japanese will be involved in the transfer, the first large movement to the Arkansas center.

Watkins, aviation radioman, third class, San Diego, Calif., were killed in a collision between two navy planes, the fifth naval district announced today. The announcement said the crash occurred late Wednesday.

PRESS CLUB FORWARDS PRISONER AID FUNDS

San Francisco, Sept. 18.—(U.P.)—The San Francisco Press club today forwarded \$36,645.51 to the American Red Cross at Washington, D. C., to pay for an entire cargo of medicinal supplies to be shipped on the exchange ship Gripsholm for American war prisoners in the Far East.

The payment represented a portion of contributions received

by the Press club for shipment of food packages and medical supplies aboard the Swedish vessel Kanangoora, whose charter was cancelled yesterday by the Red Cross.
