TREASURER FINED \$2,500 FOR KICK

Albany, N. Y., Oct. 2.—(U.P.)—Kicking your caddy should cost \$2,500 at most, an appellate division ruling held today in reversing a judgment against the treasurer of the United States, William A. Julian.

A supreme court had awarded the caddy, 19-year-old Theodore Leombruno, \$5,000 for the alleged assault. The majority of the appellate division found this "grossly excessive" and ordered a new trial unless the caddy agreed to accept \$2,500 within 10 days.

According to the caddy the assault occurred after Julian's ball landed in a dirt road.
