HORMONE BRINGS PROSTATE CANCER CONTROL IS CLAIM

British Research Credited With New Development; Few Pills Turn Trick.

London, Dec. 16.—(U.P.)—British scientists said today that a new sex hormone has been developed which for the first time in medical history enables the complete control of at least one form of cancer.

A spokesman for the Council of the British Empire Cancer campaign said British research with diethylstilbestrol has confirmed its effectiveness in the treatment of cancer of the prostate gland, a particularly painful form of the disease which usually affects men of 60 years or older.

Few Pills Daily
"For the first time in the history of mankind," the spokesman said, "it is possible to state that one form of cancer can be completely controlled and the patient rendered symptom-free by the administration of a few pills by mouth each day."

The sufferer usually is able to return to active work within a week or two after starting the treatment, although he may have to continue taking the pills for some time, depending on the degree of the malignant growth, the spokesman said.

The spokesman emphasized that at present the new hormone is known to be of value only in the treatment of prostate cancer, although some experts indicated it might prove a starting point for research leading to the treatment of other forms.

Back Room Scientist
Perfection of the new treatment was credited to Prof. E. C. Dodds, professor of bio-chemistry at London university, one of the self-styled "back room boys" of science, who followed up experiments initiated in the United States.

Dodds said the hormone originally was extracted from the urine of a pregnant mare, but that it can now be obtained synthetically through a lengthy process.

He estimated that the new treatment would save 4,000 lives annually in England and Wales.

The method of treating prostate cancer by female sex hormones was discovered in the United States by Prof. Charles B. Huggins, of the University of Chicago, who reported his findings to the American Medical association in June, 1941.

Huggins' experiments were based on the theory that imbalance of hormones in aged men played a part in causing cancer of the prostate gland. They indicated that injection of male sex hormones accelerated the cancerous growth, and he concluded that suppression of the male hormone would remove the cause.

New York, Dec. 15.—(U.P.)—Cancer specialists here were skeptical today regarding claims that cancer of the prostate gland can be "completely controlled" by treatment with the sex hormone diethylstilbestrol, though they were unanimous in saying Prof. E. C. Dodds, of the University of London, who is credited with the development of the treatment, was "one of the most able and careful men in England."
