

GAS FOR TRAVEL WHERE NECESSITY SHOWN TO BOARD

In answer to a question from the county Chamber of Commerce, the Medford war price and ration board has issued a statement to the effect that while the board realizes the travel situation between Medford and points south, and the need of relief, special gasoline for travel to these points can be issued for only a few specific purposes.

In a letter to the board Frank

Hull, manager of the chamber, stated that numerous persons had pointed out to the Chamber of Commerce the fact that delays of one and two days often result before bus space to Dunsmuir could be obtained and that the present bus service connecting with southbound Southern Pacific trains is inadequate to handle this traffic. Mr. Hull asked the board to investigate the possibility of obtaining permission to issue supplemental gasoline to citizens wishing to travel south.

Replying to Mr. Hull, Leonard Carpenter, chairman of the board, stated: "Concerning special gasoline for travel because of inadequate bus and rail service between Medford and all points south, special travel gasoline may be granted for only a very few specific purposes and then only where there is proof of a lack of adequate alternate services. I have taken up with the gasoline panels of the board the question of what can be considered 'adequate service' and it is evident that with the heavy load imposed by Camp White, plus the local needs, this region is very severely handicapped and that some relief should be given."

"Applicants with legitimate reasons for such a special allowance should consider carefully that in using their cars or this purpose they will automatically reduce their chances of ever receiving any new tires or tubes. Applications should be made on Form OPA R-552 for special gasoline with reasons for the trip. Only those will be granted to make train connections for the south at Klamath Falls or Dunsmuir."

Ration Calendar

No service on matters requiring panel action in less than 24 hours at local war price and ration board.

Ration Book No. 3
(Brown stamps for purchase of meats, fats, etc.)
Jan. 1, 1944—Expiration date of brown stamps L, M, N, P and Q becomes valid on Dec. 19.

Ration Book No. 4
(Processed fruits and vegetables, jams and jellies.)

Dec. 20—Expiration date of green stamps A, B and C.

Sugar
Jan. 15, 1944—Expiration date of stamp 29, in Book 4, good for 5 pounds.

Shoes
Stamp No. 18, Book 1, and "Airplane" stamp No. 1, book 3, valid for one pair each for indefinite period.

Fuel Oil
Jan. 3, 1944—Expiration date of period 1 coupons in new fuel oil ration.

Gasoline
Jan. 31, 1944—Expiration date of 9 stamps in A book, each good for 3 gallons.

Value of gasoline coupons: A, B1 C1, 3 gals.; B2, C2, R and T, 5 gals.; D, 1.5 gals.; E, 1 gal.

Tires
Cars with C ration books must have tires inspected every 3 months; B books every 4 months; A books every 6 months. Commercial motor vehicles—tire inspection every 6 months or every 5,000 miles, whichever comes first.
