

Control of Lumber Tightened By WPB

Washington, June 24—(U.P.)—The War Production Board, anticipating increased demand because of military requirements, today established over-all control of lumber, last basic production material in which shortages have become critical.

Effective Aug. 1, the board announced, both sawmills and

distributors of lumber will be placed under WPB control. Sawmills will be permitted to sell only on direct authorization, and distributors may sell only on certified order except to small consumers—the man who needs only a few boards to mend his fence or roof.
