Bed Linen Price Ceilings To Rise Says OPA Chief

Washington, July 5.—(U.P.)—New and higher price ceiling for major types of sheets and pillow cases, denims and other cotton textile items will be announced this week, the Office of Price Administration said today.

OPA Chief Chester Bowles said it is impossible to determine immediately the cost to consumers but that the changes should have no substantial effect on the cost of living.

"Some of the increases undoubtedly will have to be passed through to consumers," he said. "It is believed, however, that others can be absorbed in whole or in part at intermediate stages of production and distribution."
