## Never Looked Better

That conditions within Germany are bad can't be doubted. Just how bad no one at this distance can tell.

But the next week or ten days should throw a revealing light on the question.

For unless Germany has more in reserve and a far higher morale than reports for the past few weeks would indicate, the breaking point in this war must be near.

AND as has often been noted in this department, once let the Nazi edifice totter to crack, and "hold everything!"—the deluge will be something terrific. Overnight as it were, Hitler's Germany, as it has been for over a decade, might well disappear.

It would be foolish to bank on any such beneficent outcome. Surely no let-up in the intensity of the allied offensive, on any such assumption, would even be considered.

On the other hand, there is no point in dodging facts, whether they are good or bad. And that they are good in Europe today expresses the situation conservatively. Not since the war started have they been better.

## Can Hitler Take It?

Yes, one can only guess at the actual situation inside Germany. But in general there seems to be no doubt of this:

Herr Hitler is in a hotter spot than he has ever been before. For not only are his armies threatened with annihilation on every front, but he is fighting for his very life at home.

While the recent attempt to rub him out failed, there is no doubt the effort, driven underground for the moment, will soon crop out again, for the ruling class in Germany undoubtedly wants an end to the war, and certain of ultimate defeat, won't stop until they get it.

The corner stone of this ruling class is the old Junker caste,—the aristocratic militarists,—who have also controlled, until very recently at least, the German general staff.

## SO there is Der Reichsfuehrer's predicament.

He not only has to fend off complete destruction on the Russian and French fronts, he has somehow to liquidate the long established ruling class of his own Fatheland,—or all is lost.

A life-sized job for a modern Napoleon or a resurrected Bismarck. But for Herr Schickelgruber,—well, the next few weeks should show whether this bang-topped bully has,—or ever had,—anything on the ball but bluster and bombast, tied up in a yellow streak a couple of miles wide!

If he hasn't it's good night, and the time is not far distant.

## Still the \$64 Question—

As far as we can make out the outstanding war query today is the same as two years ago, i. e.:

"How long will the war last?"

Since returning from an extended eastern trip at least that question has been fired at "ye editor" almost as frequently as "Who is going to be our next President?"

And it is natural, of course.

For there is scarcely a home in this community, or any other, the happiness of which does not hang largely upon that fact,—how LONG will the war last?

And everyone, those who are directly affected, and those who aren't, want this monstrous thing to stop at the earliest possible moment.

ON the other hand, with the war going so well on all fronts,—so much better than the skipper of this department, at least, ever believed possible,—we think a little more emphasis on that cheering fact, and a little less speculation about the precise date of the end, might be in order.

Not that it makes a great deal of difference.

But there is such a thing as becoming too preoccupied with when the war will end, and thus impairing the morale so essential to cleaning it up at the minimum of time and effort.

MOREOVER, with the situation so extremely encouraging as it is today it is highly probable any layman's current prognostication of the termination date would fall far short of the probabilities from a professional standpoint. And this is strictly a professional's war. Such an outcome might lead to a sense of discouragement and disappointment when such sanguine expectations were not fulfilled, and that would be unfortunate.

So our suggestion is to ease up a bit on the great indoor sport of naming the war-end date, and concentrate upon making sure "we the people" are doing everything we can do to end it.

## "Thank You"

On behalf of myself and others in the service who have had an opportunity to enjoy the advantages of the Junior Officers' club in Medford, I wish to take this means to express at least partially our appreciation for the kindness and hospitality extended by the people of Medford and the hostesses of the Outpost.

For many of us, this is the first such club we have visited and the impression cannot help but be a lasting one. Perhaps more complimentary, however, are the reactions of those who have previously visited clubs in some of the larger cities and hence are in a position to draw comparisons. On several occasions I have heard officers express themselves as having visited clubs in Los Angeles, San Francisco or some other large city and yet felt they had found no spot where they had enjoyed themselves quite so much as at the Medford club.

## Yule Packages For Boys Overseas Due In Mail On Sept. 15

Washington, Aug. 8.—(AP)—If you want Christmas packages to arrive in time to army and navy personnel overseas, you should mail them some time between Sept. 15 and Oct. 15. Postmaster General Frank C. Walker said today.

He urged great care in addressing of parcels and the use of metal, wood or fiberboard containers. "Christmas Parcel" should be marked plainly on the outside.

Walker said parcels must not exceed five pounds nor be more than 15 inches in length or 36 in length and girth combined. Anything that might damage other mail—perishable goods, intoxicants, inflammable materials—may not be sent.

And you can't send more than one parcel a week to the same addressee.
