You will be vitally interested in the August 10th issue of the Federal Register on page 9745 which proposes that the Fluorine (Cryolite) tolerance be raised to 7 milligrams of Fluorine expressed as F per kilogram of fruit. This is roughly equivalent to .05 grains per pound. The old Fluorine tolerance was .02 grains per pound.
