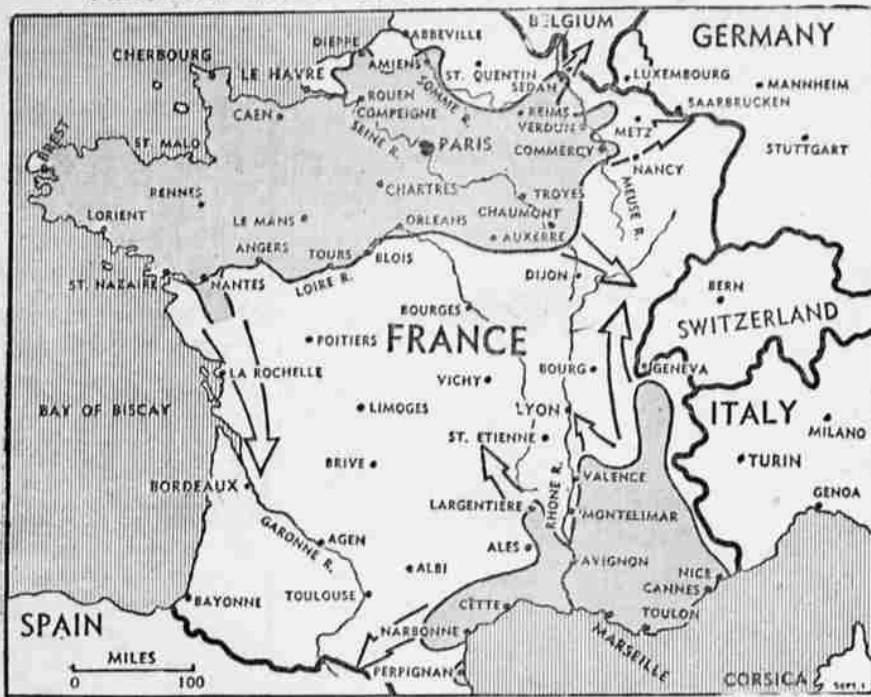


American Armor Drives Final Blows in France

Any one who cares about his or her comfort, personal appearance, health, efficiency and longevity will be satisfied with nothing less than immediate denture service if or when he or she has to lose one or more teeth. Immediate denture service requires more skill and time and patience—skill on the part of the dentist, time and patience on the part of both dentist and patient—and hence it costs more than the old method under which the victim had to ling along for weeks or months toothless while waiting for the dentist to make the denture or for the gums to heal and become firm enough to support the denture. Immediate denture service therefore costs more—and it is worth more.

The dentist who practices in this modern way takes the impression before extraction of the tooth or teeth, prepares the denture, and then proceeds to install the denture immediately after extraction, before the patient leaves the office. Of course it is not always applicable, even if the dentist has the requisite technical skill, and neither is the denture always entirely comfortable for the first few days, and in most instances the dentist will have to make minor adjustments or alterations of the denture. But on the other hand, many patients declare they have no more discomfort in the first few days than one would expect to have after extraction of one or several teeth, and often enough even members of the patient's own family are unaware that the patient has had any teeth extracted.

Contrary to popular fancy, the healing of the gums is not only not hampered by the denture but the denture acts rather as a control and support for the new gum tissue and promotes more regular formation of new tissue for the support of the denture. Much more important than the mere embarrassment of

being toothless is the rapid change in the contour of the face that inevitably accompanies toothlessness—a sagging from flabbiness and a shortening of the distance between nose and chin, changes so familiarly caricatured in the representation of a witch or an old hag. And still more important than this loss of whatever good looks the individual may have had, is the impairment of oral digestion which attends loss of the function of mastication. This in the course of weeks or months brings not just the appearance of premature old age but the nutritional deficiency which is physiological old age.

I repeat, immediate denture service is not always applicable even if the dentist is skilled in this method and the patient is eager to have it. But in most instances, if too many teeth have not already been lost, it is the method of choice for the individual who values his or her comfort, appearance, efficiency and health.

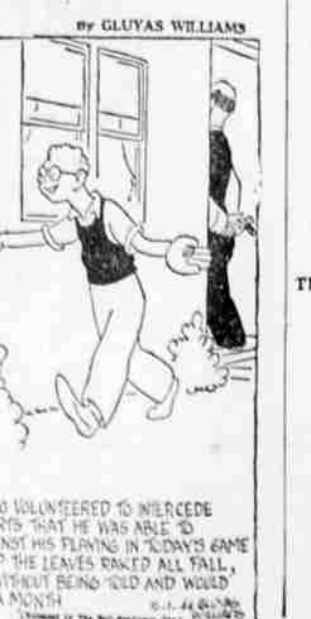
