NAZARENE CHURCH IN CAMPAIGN TO REACH 2 MILLION

The local Church of the Nazarene is engaging in the program outlined by its headquarters authorization of making two million contacts during October. The slogan for this campaign representing the Church of the Nazarene is "Evangelical in Faith, Evangelical in Purpose, Missionary in Spirit, Friendly in Attitude, Community-wide in Interest, World-wide in Vision and Informal in its Services."

Statistics recently given out by the demonstration show an increase in membership of 183 per cent from 1926 to 1942, the largest increase in the United States denominations having 50,000 members or over. Church of the Nazarene membership at present is approximately 200,000. In 1943 they raised the sum of \$10,000,000 for all purposes representing the largest per capita giving among twenty American denominations affiliated with the United Stewardship Council for 1943. This is slightly over \$54 per capita.

The Church of the Nazarene set for its goal the raising of a million dollars for foreign missions and the sending out of forty missionaries during 1944. The Medford Church of the Nazarene is uniting with other churches of the city in a great Rally Day Sunday. At 9:45 a. m. the Sunday school department is sponsoring a program. At 10:45 a. m. the Rev. Fred M. Weatherford, pastor, speaks on "The Church and Religious Freedom." At 7:30 p. m. his topic is, "The Justice of God." New members will be received in church fellowship at the morning worship hour. The young people have planned a rally service at 6:30 p. m. in the interest of the Alaskan missionary project.
