

# JAPANESE DEATH TOLL 12,211 IN PELELIU BATTLE

U. S. Pacific Fleet Headquarters Pearl Harbor, Oct. 7.—U. S. forces using tanks and artillery made some progress against stubbornly-held enemy positions on Umurogrol mountain in the 23rd day of fighting on Peleliu island Friday as the Japanese death toll continued to mount. Chester W. Nimitz announced today.

The communique said that the total enemy dead on Peleliu and Angaur was now 12,211 including 11,083 on Peleliu and 1,128 on Angaur.

The figures showed an increase of 1,205 on Peleliu and 19 on Angaur since Nimitz' last casualty report Oct. 4, indicating that the battle of the southern Palau is still not won.

"Our forces captured 214 prisoners on Peleliu and 10 on Angaur," the communique said.

The bitterness of the fighting on Peleliu has not slackened in recent weeks with the Japanese waging a death stand on 100-foot high Umurogrol.

The enemy stronghold apparently can be wiped out only by the methodical digging out and elimination of every Japanese rifleman and machine gunner holding out in caves and crevices.
